Brotherly Love



During their young lives, almost 7-year-old Josh, and his 10-year-old brother, Cody experienced trauma that is hard to imagine. When teachers at Cody's school noticed signs of malnourishment and possible physical abuse, child protective services stepped in. An initial evaluation revealed that Josh was not attending daycare or any pre-kindergarten programs, was non-verbal, and had numerous physical symptoms of developmental abnormalities. The boys were immediately admitted to the hospital and while under a doctor's care, it was discovered that the children were also victims of sexual abuse - especially Cody.

After their discharge from the hospital, the brothers were immediately removed from their home and placed into foster care. Sadly, due to his profound trauma and ensuing emotional turmoil, Cody remained in the hospital longer than Josh, and at one point was admitted to a psychiatric hospital for a few days. Although it is rare, the abuse in their household was so extreme, the court instantly terminated parental rights, rather than pursuing reunification. In many situations, siblings who enter foster care are prone to being separated from one another, due to lack of space, resources, and proper care. Although Josh was a little young for the Kids Village program, after careful consideration of the boys' history, it was determined that their needs could be met with the guidance and support of the CHN caregiver team.

As soon as they arrived at campus, Josh's speech impairment and limitations and Cody's mental health were very apparent. Josh's verbal skills were limited to approximately 20 words, similar to that of a toddler under the age of 2. Josh did not know how to communicate with his caregivers or how to play with other children. Unlike Josh, Cody did not appear to have the same developmental or language deficiencies, but his fragile mental health was a daily struggle for him to maintain. The CHN staff initiated services right away, providing mental health counseling, Applied Behavior Analysis services and additional interventions to help the boys heal.

Over time, Josh and Cody started to adapt to their new environment and became more trusting of their caregivers and other children. Unfortunately, Cody's trauma was often more than he could bear, and he would burst into rages or emotional spirals, physically attacking other youth and staff while in an uncontrollable episode. In order to keep him and others safe, Cody was hospitalized several times. Eventually, it was determined that Cody needed a more intense mental health program, and he transitioned from campus into a Specialized Therapeutic Group home where he received intensive mental health services while maintaining visitation with his younger brother.

Meanwhile, through the advocacy and commitment of CHN staff, Josh has undergone extensive medical, neurological, genetic and psychological testing and it was determined that in addition to intellectual disabilities, he also has rare genetic syndromes and a heart condition. Due to the neglect also experienced while in the home, Josh has required ongoing medical and dental follow up, and has undergone surgeries to improve his hearing and health.

Currently, Josh is a much-loved member of the Kids Village family and is thriving in our care. He is a good student who enjoys school and has many friends. Josh's vocabulary has increased to that of a typical five-year-old, and he is excelling in speech therapy. Cody remains in a Specialized setting where he is receiving mental health services and will eventually transition back to CHN or to an adoptive family with his brother. Kids Village is the only home these brothers have ever known outside of their own. The Children's Home Network is thankful for the generosity and support of friends like you, who help create safe spaces and services to meet the unique and unexpected needs of children like Josh and Cody. We are confident that despite Josh and Cody's tragic past, they have a bright future with an adoptive family who can meet their needs and embrace them with loving arms.

Julia's Story



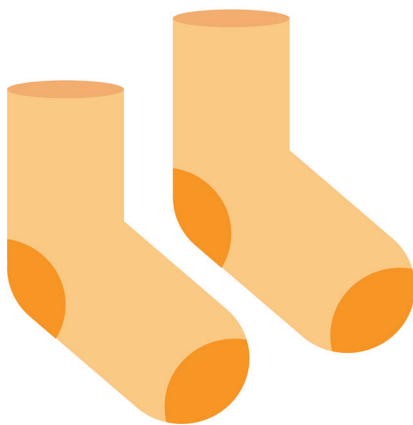
As a third grader, 8-year-old Julia struggled academically with writing, math, and reading on-grade level. After a Family Team Conference was held, it was determined that Julia was the ideal candidate for the Children's Home Network's Supporting and Empowering Educational and Developmental Services (SEEDS) program.

Through SEEDS, she has received one-on-one tutoring, grade-level reading books, assistance with public transportation to safely get her to and from school, and an educational tablet to help her advance in the classroom.

Julia is currently on her fourth round of private tutoring and is exceling! She reads bi-lingual books daily with her mom and uses her tablet regularly to practice math on educational websites. She is now on grade-level in writing and math and is quickly catching up with her reading.

In addition to Julia's progress, the SEEDS program also connected her mother with an English class and tools to help her learn the English language. Currently, her mom is working as a teacher assistant at Julia's school where she is able to practice her English on a daily basis and support Julia with her academics. 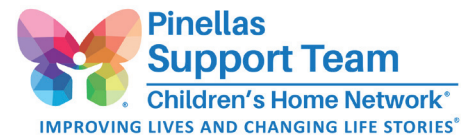

Sam's Healing Journey



Although a teenager, 17-year-old Sam lacked safe, stable housing and guidance from his parents. In fact, he was not in the care of a parent or guardian at all - but, instead, couch surfing with friends at the time he began services with the Pinellas Support Team (PST).

Sam had not lived with a caretaker for over a year. As a young child, he was a victim of his parent's divorce, which led to a custody battle when his father began seeing someone new. His mother won full custody and his father moved out of state. Unfortunately, after the move, Sam no longer had a relationship with his father. This was devastating for Sam, who longed for his presence as a little boy. Sam's relationship with his mother also suffered when she prevented him from attending school in order to be his younger sister's full time caregiver. Understandably, Sam became extremely resentful and angry towards her.

Finally, when Sam was able to return to school, he was a year behind. School personnel helped him to enroll in a special program for credit recovery. However, Sam continued to struggle. He was referred to the PST program by his school's social worker who became concerned after learning about his severe depression and anxious behavior which made it difficult for him to communicate readily, make eye contact, concentrate, and interact with others. In addition to struggling emotionally, Sam's academics were also suffering.



Initially, when Sam started working with his PST counselor, he participated in telehealth services through the Zoom platform. His insecurities were so severe that he refused to show himself on camera. The counselor worked with him to develop trust providing a safe non-judgmental environment for him to share his thoughts and feelings. As trust continued to build, Sam worked up his courage to turn his camera on during sessions so he could be seen by his counselor. Eventually they progressed to some face-to-face sessions. As Sam continued to face his fear and shame, he actively participated during his therapy sessions. As Sam opened up to his counselor it was learned that even though Sam's father moved back to Florida about 5 years ago, he had only connected with Sam 3 times since then. In addition, Sam shared that he was also cared for by an older sister, who left when she could because of the mother's expectations to care for younger siblings. This seemed to explain his feelings of neglect and abandonment he felt towards his family.

Sam has made tremendous achievements with the support of his counselor through the Pinellas Support Team. He is able to identify his triggers and address conflict before it becomes too much to handle. Sam is also working to repair and strengthen the relationships with his mother and father by practicing effective communication skills about his childhood trauma. He also continues to invest in his friendships, who have become his greatest support in his healing journey.

Even though he was a year behind, Sam was able to finish and graduate from High School earlier than anticipated. At the end of his counseling program with the Pinellas Support Team, he agreed to a referral for another provider for ongoing services to continue supporting his mental health. Sam shared that he felt better than he ever had, and proudly stated that he was working two jobs and even enrolled himself into college this Spring. Way to go, Sam!

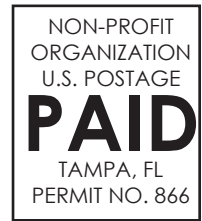
